

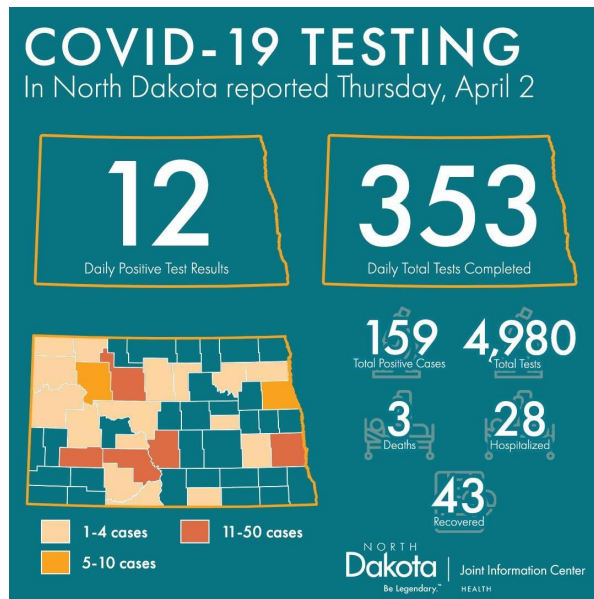

NORTH DAKOTA CORONAVIRUS UPDATE AS OF APRIL 2, 2020

The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDOH) today confirmed twelve additional cases of novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The cases confirmed as of 11 a.m., include 6 from the Fargo area, 2 in Stark County, 1 from the Minot area, 1 in Williams County, and 1 in Mountrail County. There have been **4,980 total tests with 159**



positive cases, 28 hospitalized and 3 deaths. (These numbers are just from 3pm-12 am yesterday, tomorrow will be a full 24 reporting period, so the number will be higher). [Odney Advertising](#) provides daily updates directly from the [ND Department of Health](#).

TOWN & COUNTRY AWARDED HOMEOWNERSHIP AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

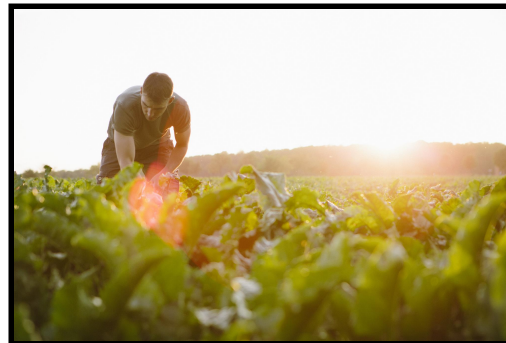
